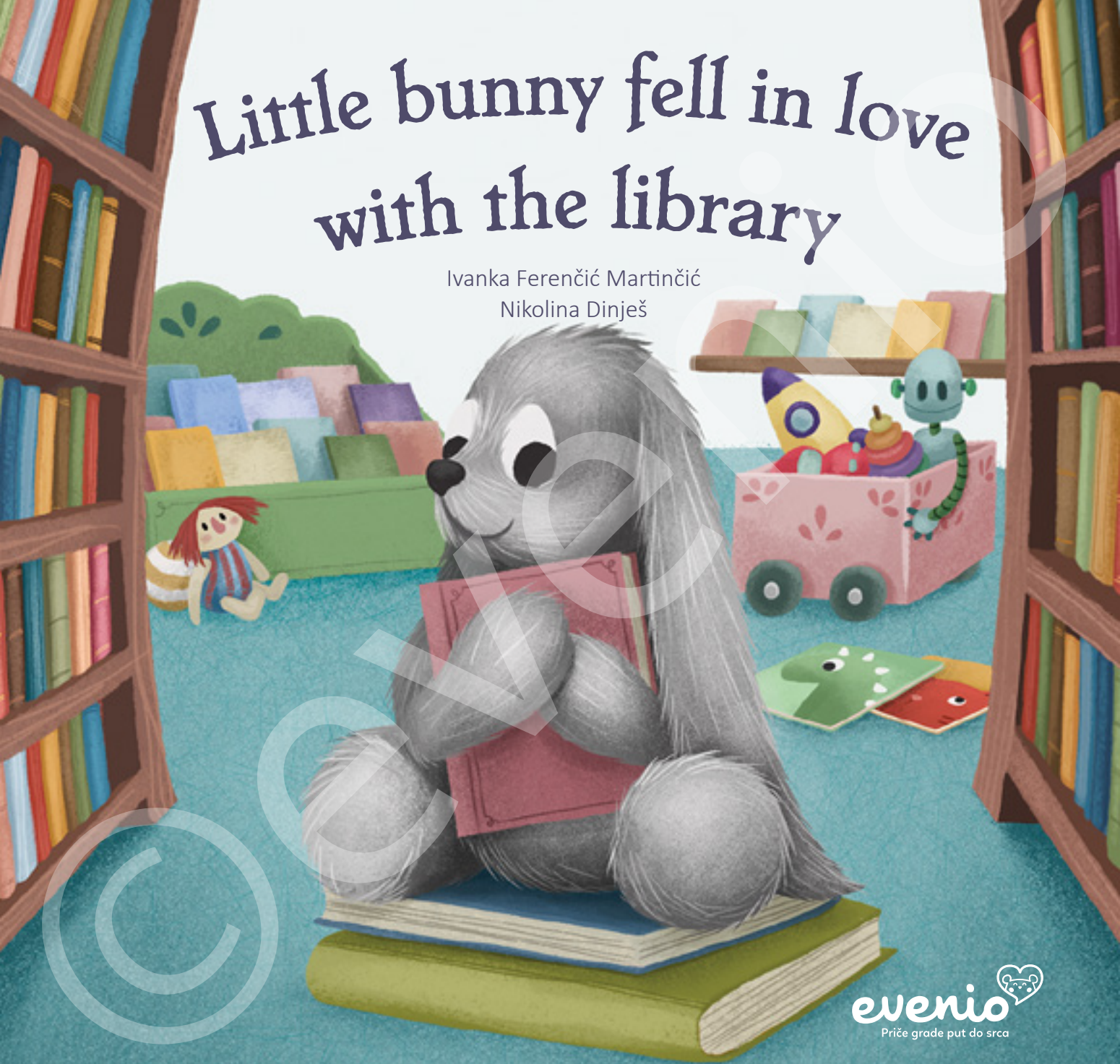

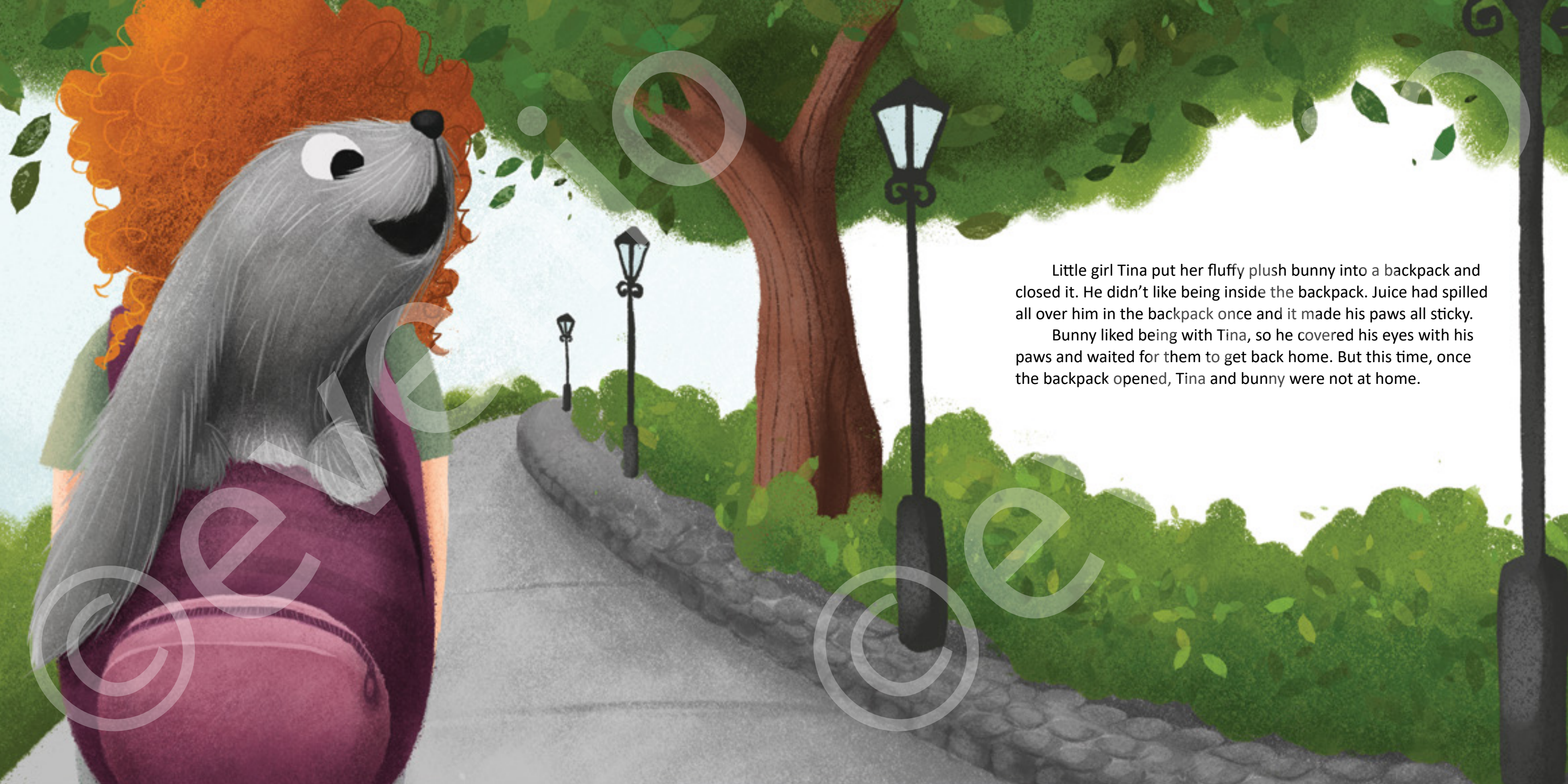
# Little bunny fell in love with the library
